The syntax and functions described here apply to the LOAD statement, and not to the SELECT statement, since the latter is interpreted by the ODBC driver and not by Qlik Sense.However, most ODBC drivers are often capable of interpreting a number of the functions described below.

FALSE, so can be used in the where clause of a LOAD statement or an IF function.
