Signs and symptoms at the site of a scorpion sting may include: Pain, which can be intense; Numbness and tingling; Slight swelling; Warmth; Signs and symptoms related to widespread (systemic) venom effects usually occur in children who are stung and may include: Difficulty breathing; Muscle twitching or thrashing; Unusual head, neck and eye movements; Drooling

Scorpion sting - Symptoms and causes - Mayo Clinic

Thirty-four patients with severe scorpion sting were reviewed and pertinent data related to the cardiovascular system such as hypertension, peripheral vascular collapse, congestive heart failure or pulmonary edema were analyzed. The electrocardiograms of 28 patients were reviewed; 14 patients showed [early myocardial infarction-like] pattern.

Scorpion stings occurred mostly outdoors (66%). Medical complications associated with scorpion sting cases included fever, difficulty in breathing, drowsiness and dizziness, and numbness, while severe complications include respiratory failure and tachycardia. Hospitalization required 1 to 3 days among admitted patients with no fatalities.

Supportive care Cold compress to area of sting; Analgesic and anti-inflammatory medications; Benzodiazepines may help with agitation and muscle spasms; Intubation for pulmonary symptoms is rare, but may be necessary; Atropine

Scorpion Envenomation Questions & Answers

Scorpion stings and envenomation | In most cases, the sting causes local effects including: pain, oedema, erythema. Management includes strict rest, wound cleansing, analgesics PO, and tetanus prophylaxis (see Tetanus, Chapter 7). In patients with significant pain, infiltrate the area around the sting with local anaesthetic (1% lidocaine).

Management of scorpion stings is primarily symptomatic. Patients with signs and symptoms of envenoming must be monitored for the possible development of cardiac arrhythmias or sudden changes in arterial blood pressure.

A single randomized controlled clinical trial had been carried out in Turkey to evaluate this important aspect of scorpion sting management . They evaluated three methods of pain relief: paracetamol (1 g intravenous single dose), topical 5% lidocaine and ice application over the sting site.

Other therapies : DIC, sub-dural hematoma and hemiplegia, hypoxic brain damage with generalized brain edema are known to occur and should be treated with fresh blood transfusion and decongestive treatment. If the victim becomes delirious or comatose, hyperbaric oxygen might help.
